FINANCES / SCHOOL FEES

Thank you to the parents who faithfully paid their school fees. Just a friendly reminder of the following:

- All school fees must be paid in full by the 7th of every month. Fees are payable in advance.
- Parents are requested to check their monthly statement to ensure that all payments are reflected. If a payment does not appear on your statement, please email proof of payment to accounts@theway.co.za in order for the finance department to reconcile the account. Please ensure that you provide a reference number or name on all payments.
- All enquiries with regard to your child/children's



school fees must be made in writing within 30 days from the statement date. After the 30-day period has lapsed and no written correspondence has been received, the statement will be accepted as correct. It is recommended that correspondence regarding accounts be emailed to accounts@theway.co.za.

- Our school is cash free but when you have to send cash, please ensure that all money sent to school is in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name, grade, what the money's for and the amount of money included. Most payments can be made on the Karri App.
- As far as School Fees are concerned, please make direct deposits into the school's account.
 We are trying to maintain a cash free environment at the school for the safety of our learners and staff.

We would like to encourage all parents to preferably make use of the debit order option as opposed to an EFT. The forms are available at reception.
